

Guidelines in Selecting and Awarding
The Joseph F. and Nannie H. Tyndall Scholarship

Applicants

- May be either male or female.
- Must be of the Baptist Faith and an active member of First Baptist Church of Deep Run
- Must be seeking education beyond the high school level.
- Application should be filed by the applicant no later than the third Sunday of May of each year to the Joseph F. and Nannie H. Tyndall Scholarship Committee Chairperson who is the Senior Pastor. In the event there is no Senior Pastor, the Chairperson of the Deacons will fill this position.

Recipient

- Shall have a definite desire to better serve God through higher education.
- Shall have met entrance requirements and be accepted by a post secondary institution (accredited college, university, technical, or community college).
- Exhibit high moral character, dedication to family, church, community, and have been active in the First Baptist Church of Deep Run ministries.

Scholarship

- Shall be awarded on a one-year basis and not renewable for any following years.
- Will be awarded to one recipient at the discretion of the committee, and in the amount of \$250.00. This amount can be increased at the discretion of the Tyndall family.
- Scholarship will be awarded during the morning worship service on the Sunday honoring the high school graduates.
- The Scholarship Committee (consisting of the active deacons and senior Pastor) reserves the right to make no grant in any one year should there be no applicant who, in the opinion of the committee, qualifies according to all requirements of these guidelines.
- In the event that First Baptist Church of Deep Run ceases to exist, the funds remaining in the CD will be donated in the names of Joseph F. and Nannie H. Tyndall to South Lenoir High School Media Center.

Church Activities: list all church activities, positions of leadership and honors in connection with your church. Attach a separate sheet if needed.

School Activities: list all school activities including sports, clubs, and other school organizations of which you have been a member; list school letters won, school honors, class or club offices held, and all other school activities or honors. Attach a separate sheet if needed.

Community and Other Activities: list all community activities of which you have been a part, positions of leadership, honors received, including any community service projects in which you have participated. Attach a separate sheet if needed.

Statement of Education and Career Goals: On a separate sheet briefly summarize your goals and plans for your education and career.
